Treasurer's Report:

We had \$2268.25 in income and \$8496.98 in expenses. This includes paying \$6761,36 to ASB for the kids accounts. Checking account Balance: \$16,986.72

Band Directors Report: Scott called Mr. T and had a strong prospect on the Piano. The cost presented to the potential buyer was \$9000. We are waiting for a counter offer. If we go down to \$8000 then after repairs, moving & commission, we could make around \$5900.

Monica has access to a golf cart and a trailer for free if we are willing to work around the end of his golf season in September, beginning of October. At the end of the marching band season, we could possibly buy it. Laura & Erica found a 4 seat golf cart that we could purchase for \$1600 that has already been serviced, and has good batteries.

Tracy brought up the idea of purchasing a used school bus, gutting it, and turning it into a food truck. We could have stoves, counter tops, cabinets, refridgeraters, ect.. We could have electrical outlets so we could run the roasters.

With Sonja's new job, she does not have the availability to be food coordinator. We are so thankful for her help and she did an amazing job.

Dessert Social: T will have 3 packets for the kids. One is due that night, one is due Monday, and the final one is due August 19th. We will need to have the payments for Chewela before July 1st. T is going to try to reduce band fees to \$150 since we are not going to Everett this year, which our most expensive trip. Music is Pandora Reopened.

Fundraiser:

Color Run: We are going to postpone it until Spring. It will take too many volunteers right at the same time as Showcase.

Car Wash: Went smooth. We raised \$463.25 in drive up sales. Still waiting for a couple of kids to turn in tickets & money.

Christmas Tree Elegance: Valley Mall is willing to let us set up trees there, and they will advertise for us. We will have to rent a Kiosk to sell the tickets for the week, and get businesses to donate tree packages. Chamber Orchestra will play a couple of the days. This could be a huge fundraiser!

New Business:

Color Guard – Joleen & Sunshine went to Boosters with a wish list, and they got everything they asked for and \$2400.

Showcase – John & Kerry will not be able to run showcase. They will still be able to help in the background, but they will need someone to be the front person. Perhaps we could get some corporate sponsors.
