Treasurer's Report: Beginning cash balance of \$19,689.23. We had deposits of \$5792.62 and expenses of \$1431.78. Ending Checking balance is \$24,050.07. Charms student total is \$6761.36 which is going to ASB, going to fine accounts. Cash Balance General Fund \$17,288.71.

Band Directors Report: Made it through the Parade in Wenatchee & Color guard won 1st place in AAAA. Lilac Parade kids will load the bus at 3:45pm & will leave for downtown at 4:00pm. 6:45pm is our official arrival time. 7:15 is our official stage time. We are # 57 in the parade. On Carwash day (May 30th) Mr. T. will be here to help set up, but he has Chamber Orchestra auditions that day. Would love for us to do something in Vancouver, BC on May 26-29th 2016. It would be the entire band and orchestra could also participate. Marching band may go to Auburn instead of Tacoma in the fall.
